Ultrasounds:

At our office, every patient will get at least 3 ultrasounds. Your first scan will verify your due date at approximately 8 weeks. Your next ultrasound is the anatomy scan at 20 weeks. We also routinely perform a growth ultrasound at 32 weeks. We offer additional ultrasounds that you can choose to schedule. These include a gender scan at 16 weeks and/or a 3D/4D scan around 28 weeks. These optional scans need to be scheduled in advance. A full bladder is not necessary for any of your obstetric ultrasounds.

Family and friends are always welcome to attend your ultrasounds. We don't want them to miss it, so we do ask for all members to be present at your scheduled appointment time.
